

Associate Professor, PhDr. Tomas Surý, ArtD. is a graduate of the Faculty of Humanities University of Trnava, studying the history of art and culture (1992-1997, rigorous test 2007) and the Faculty of Music and Dance at University of Music and Drama Arts in Bratislava, Opera Director (2001-2006).
